DEVONIAN PARK WILDLIFE SPECIES INVENTORY

There are many distinct ecosystems within Devonian Park which support a large and varied wildlife population. Birds and mammals are abundant throughout the park from the woodland to the waters. A random wildlife survey conducted June 3, 1981 revealed some of the following species; as well as further information from Wayne Campbell, B.C. Provincial Museum.
